## PRACTICAL NURSING PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Items listed below must be submitted for the admission process to be complete. All information must be completed and submitted to [admissions@tcathohenwald.edu](mailto:admissions@tcathohenwald.edu) in PDF format. Requirements may also be submitted in-person to the TCAT – Hohenwald Front Office or by mail. Classes will be chosen based on applicant eligibility; if a class has more eligible applicants than available seats, HESI scores will determine ranking.

  - Must be official – contact the institution that awarded document(s) and have them send document(s) to TCAT – Hohenwald.

\*\*If you cannot provide proof of vaccination, a lab titer proving immunity is required\*\*

# HESI Exam Information

- Each applicant must provide passing HESI Exam results. *Minimum* HESI Exam scores for entrance into the Practical Nursing Program are **70** on Reading Comprehension AND **70** on Math.
- The HESI Exam is offered at TCAT – Hohenwald every month. Please check the TCAT – Hohenwald website for HESI Exam dates or call (931) 796-5351. A 2024 Schedule is included in this packet.
- The exam will begin at 9:00AM. If this session fills up, a 12:30PM session will be offered.
- Thursday/Friday times are only available following a Prep Class. A Friday date may be opened if the prior Thursday test day is completely filled.
- Each HESI Exam costs \$47 and is **nonrefundable**. Applicants must sign up and pay **before** the test date; a seat will not be held without payment.
- On test day, applicants must provide a state-issued photo ID with signature (i.e., a TN Driver's License).
- HESI Prep classes are offered at TCAT – Hohenwald at least three times per year. This is an 8-hour class. the cost is \$15, **nonrefundable**.
- If the class you are applying for has more eligible applicants than available seats, the class will be chosen based on highest HESI scores. Failing scores will not be accepted; if you are not successful on your first attempt, you may retake the HESI. You must pay the fee each time you take the exam.
- **Call (931) 796-5351 to schedule to take the HESI Exam or HESI Prep class.**

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid determines if the applicant is eligible for federal (PELL, SEOG) and state funds (WN Lottery, TSAA).

When electronically filing, you should receive a confirmation number when your application processes. TCAT – Hohenwald may be contacted 3-5 days from confirmation date.

**You must have a high school diploma, HiSET or GED in order to qualify for Financial Aid. If you are under the age of 24, single, or do not have children, then you are considered a dependent of your parents and must report their tax information. (If you filed taxes, you must also report your tax information.)**

\*\*\*Please make sure that you have filed your financial aid and that it is **complete** before your desired enrollment



# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## **What do I need to do if I have not had (2) MMR doses?**

You must get the doses (30 days between each dose) or get a lab titer that proves immunity.

## **I didn't have (2) MMR doses and got the lab titers, but I'm not immune. What now?**

You must get the MMR vaccination. Once you receive the shots, you must turn in records.

## **I had the chickenpox as a child, but never went to the doctor for records. What do I do?**

You must get a lab titer done to prove immunity. If your lab titer does not confirm immunity, you must get the vaccination for varicella.

## **I was a child when I received these vaccinations, and I don't remember where my records are.**

### **What do I need to do?**

Contact your state's health department. Some states have registries that include vaccines. If you can't prove immunization, you can have titer(s) drawn to prove immunity. If your titer(s) result show nonimmunity, you must have the vaccination(s).

## **I took the HESI exam and didn't make a passing grade. Does this mean I won't get into the class?**

You must pass the HESI exam to be eligible for acceptance into the Practical Nursing Program at TCAT Hohenwald. You have the option to retake the exam to increase your score. The highest scores will be chosen for the class.

## **I scheduled to take the HESI exam, but couldn't make it to take the test. Will I need to pay again?**

Yes, the test is non-refundable. If something comes up prior to the test date, please call and let us know so we can see what your options are.

## **When will I receive my HESI scores?**

Immediately; you will leave the testing area and go directly to the front office for your scores.

## **How long does it take to complete the HESI exam?**

You are allotted 2 ½ hours to complete the exam. You may finish early.

## **Can I bring a calculator and notes for the HESI exam?**

No, a calculator and scratch paper will be provided if needed.

## **I do not qualify for any financial aid. Does TCAT Hohenwald offer student loans?**

No, unfortunately we do not offer student loans. There are lots of scholarship opportunities out there to receive funding. Contact TCAT – Hohenwald if you need help.

## **How will I know if I got accepted into the Program?**

You will be sent a letter of acceptance to the email address you put on your application. Once you are accepted into the Program and classes begin, you will receive more instructions for submitting other requirements.
