The Free Application for Federal Student Aid determines if the applicant is eligible for federal (PELL, SEOG) and state funds (WN Lottery, TSAA).

When electronically filing, you should receive a confirmation number when application processes. TCAT Hohenwald may be contacted 3-5 days from confirmation date.

You must have a high school diploma, Hi-Set, or GED in order to qualify for Financial Aid. If you are under the age of 24, single, or do not have children, then you are considered a dependent of your parents and must report their tax information. (If you filed taxes, you must also report your tax information.)

\*\*\*Please make sure that you have filed your financial aid and that it is **complete** before your desired enrollment date.

### **HESI Prep Class and Test Dates**

- \* Entrance into the Surgical Technology program is based on complete college AND program applications (including <u>all</u> required additional documentation) as well as HIGHEST HESI scores.
- \* You may re-take HESI as many times as you wish to secure the highest possible score. Proctors will keep only the highest scores. Scores are good for two years.
- \* Taking the entrance exam well in advance ensures you have multiple opportunities to re-take the exam and achieve the highest possible score.
- \* 8:00 AM sessions must be filled **prior** to opening the 12:30 PM session.
- \* Each HESI test is \$47 (non-refundable). Must sign up <u>before</u> the test date.
- \* Each HESI Prep Class is an 8-hour class at \$15 (non-refundable).
- \* Minimum HESI exam scores for entrance to the Surgical Technology Program are **70** on Reading Comprehension and **70** on Math.
- \* On test day, you must provide a state issued photo ID with signature (i.e. TN Driver's License).

### **Note for Prospective Students:**

While exceptionally rewarding professionally, personally, and financially, Surgical Technology is a very physically demanding profession. Surgical Technologists stand for long periods of time, with minimal breaks, repeatedly lift heavy objects, and are exposed to various hazards in a high-pressure, fast-moving, and demanding environment which requires exceptional critical thinking and problem-solving skills. It is important that you are aware of the realities of this profession.

If you have any physical limitations that would prevent you from meeting any of the above requirements, I encourage you to consider this decision carefully.

### **FAQ SHEET**

- PLEASE READ CAREFULLY: Vaccination/Immunization Records are NOT the same as Titers.
   Vaccination/Immunization Records indicate when and for what you have been vaccinated. Titers are blood lab results that indicate the diseases to which your body is Immune/Non-Immune. All applicants MUST submit <u>BOTH Immunization</u> <u>Records AND Lab Titer Results for all diseases listed</u> in the application packet. Titers can be obtained from primary care physicians, walk-in clinics, and potentially your local Health Dept.
- 2. All requested documentation MUST be originals/copies of originals. Photographs of documentation are NOT acceptable. You may scan & email, fax, hand deliver, or mail your documents to Admissions. Call 931-796-5351 for Admissions contact information.
- 3. What do I need to do if I do not have (2) MMR doses? Or I didn't have (2) MMR doses and got the lab titer, but I'm not immune. What do I need to do? You must receive the doses (required 30 days between each dose) and get a lab titer result that proves immunity.
- 4. I have received the Hepatitis B vaccine series but Titers show I am Non-Immune. What do I need to do? You must receive another round of the Hep B vaccine and have your titers redrawn according to the physician's timeline. This takes months, so begin as soon as you are aware.
- 5. I had chickenpox as a child, but never went to the doctor for records. What do I need to do? You must get a lab titer result that proves immunity.
- **6.** I was a child when I received these vaccinations. I do not remember where my records are. What do I need to do? Contact your state health department. Some states have registries that include vaccines.
- 7. I took the HESI exam and didn't make a passing grade. Does this mean I won't get into the class? You may schedule another HESI exam. Call (931) 796-5351. The highest scores will be chosen for the class. Taking the entrance exam well in advance ensures you have multiple opportunities to re-take the exam and achieve the highest possible score.
- 8. I scheduled to take the HESI exam but couldn't make it to take the test. Will I need to pay again? Call (931) 796-5351
- 9. When will I receive my HESI scores? On testing day, after testing you should report to the front office to receive your scores.
- 10. How long does it take to complete the HESI exam? You are allotted 2 ½ hours to complete the exam. You can finish early.
- 11. Can I bring a calculator and notes for the HESI exam? No, we will provide a calculator and scratch paper if needed.
- 12. I do not qualify for any financial aid. Does TCAT-Hohenwald offer student loans?

  No, unfortunately we do not offer student loans. However, there are many educational and Surgical Technology scholarships and grant opportunities available for students to pursue. American Job Centers also offer student assistance for unemployed and eligible candidates. Contact Student Services for information.
- 13. How will I know if I am accepted into the program? You will be sent an email and a letter of acceptance to the email and mailing address you provided in your application and contact form.
- **14. If I do not get accepted into the program, when will the next class be?** The Surgical Technology program begins in January and ends in December, with enrollment to be completed the year prior to the year of planned enrollment.
- 15. Once I've applied and been accepted, what is the next step? Your Program Acceptance Letter will have instructions for you to complete a background check and drug screen which will need to be sent directly to Admissions by the vendor. Do NOT attempt to obtain these items until you have received the instructions in the Acceptance Letter. Once you receive your Acceptance Letter, you will also need to confirm your placement/seat in the program by logging into your MyTCAT Portal and Registering for the Spring Term by the published deadline. Failure to do will result in a loss of placement in the program. Lastly, you will need to attend one of the Mandatory New Student Orientation Sessions offered through Admissions.
